What is The Community Free Clinic?

The Community Free Clinic is a non-profit organization that was created to help Cabarrus County residents obtain health care who otherwise would not be able to afford it. Each night that the clinic operates, a group of volunteers come together to operate the facility and lend their expertise. These persons include medical doctors, nurses, pharmacists, lab technicians, social workers and office support personnel. This organization represents a partnership between the medical community and the community at large in helping low-income, uninsured residents obtain necessary medical care. The Community Free Clinic depends on donations, fundraisers and United Way funds to operate.

Eligibility

Services are provided to those who are qualified for the Community Care Plan. Qualifications for the Community Care Plan are:

- Cabarrus County residents for at least 30 days
- Persons who do not have or are not eligible for private health insurance, Medicare or Medicaid
- Household income less than or equal to 125% of Federal Poverty guidelines

How to Apply

- Prospective patients should apply for the Community Care Plan at Cabarrus County Department of Social Services, 1303 S. Cannon Blvd. in Kannapolis, Monday through Friday from 8am till 4pm.
- Applicants must **provide two (2) proofs of residency in Cabarrus County for at least 30 days, a photo id AND proof of current household income** to apply for the Community Care Plan.

Clinic Hours

Tuesdays from 6PM–8PM and Thursdays from 9AM-4PM. The Community Free Clinic is CLOSED every Friday.

Dental Services

Volunteer dentists come once a month to evaluate patients for referrals to area dentists for extractions at no charge. To get an appointment for the Dental Clinic call the first business Tuesday of each month starting at 9:15 AM. The dental clinics are normally held the second Tuesday night of each month.

Services Provided:

- Primary care provided by volunteer physicians
- Prescription medications from our formulary as prescribed by volunteer physicians
- Referrals to specialists are made by our volunteer physicians.
- Dental extractions as referred by volunteer dentists once a month

Services NOT Provided

- Routine or sports physicals
- Well baby checkups, immunizations and prenatal care are provided by the Cabarrus Health Alliance
- Emergency care, suspected heart attacks, stroke or serious injury are best dealt with by an emergency room. Call 911 or ASK FIRST at (704) 783-1275 in these situations.
- Vision screenings and hearing aids
- Problems with drug/alcohol abuse or psychological problems are handled by Daymark.
- Problems such as venereal disease are handled by the Cabarrus Health Alliance.
